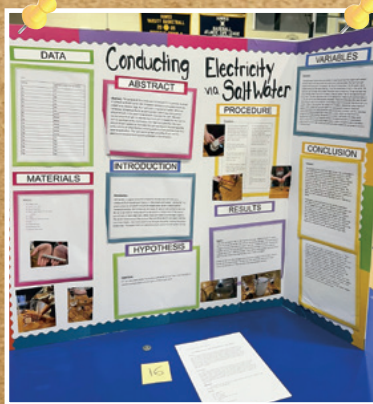

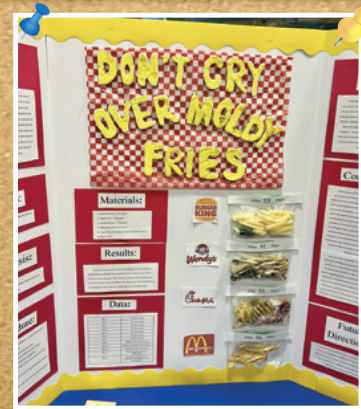

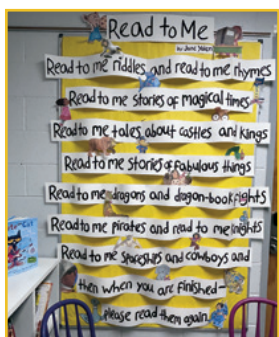

School Garden NEWS UPDATE



Another terrific and exciting year in our school garden. Once again a **BIG** thank you to Jim House, Paul Ludgate, Mrs. Christine Lacy and Sister Judy. Our energetic 5th and 7th graders who are in our school garden club who built once again a new area of our garden. As our garden expands it is getting better and better. This year the garden club built a new Sensory Garden.

Adding a Sensory Garden to our school's successful vegetable garden has been wonderful. It would be especially beneficial to grades PreK 3 to Grade 2 when teaching curriculum standards. Grades 3-8 would benefit from its calm atmosphere. We also added a book box with all kinds of books related to our garden theme for the teachers to share with their students. Possible plants that will engage all five senses such as:

Taste: mint, cherry tomatoes, mignonette strawberries, ...

Smell: lavender, hyacinth, lily of the valley, sweet autumn clematis, honeysuckle, chamomile,

Touch: Lamb's ear, ornamental grasses, rosemary, salvia also smooth stones that surround the bed as well as some smooth pottery for mint...

Sound: grasses that will move, plants that will attract winged friends; butterfly bush, black eyed susan, lavender, spider wort, also wind chimes.

Sight: colorful plants such as: Dahlias, Phlox, bearded iris, (the list is endless...).

At the beginning of this school year September 2025, we are planning on having an official ribbon cutting ceremony to bless all that will use the garden and what will grow to help enhance our learning in our new school year.

With all our improvements the garden area is filled with wonderful herbs and vegetables, a fantastic pumpkin patch and now our new addition with our sensory garden.

We are looking forward to another exciting year with many new ideas.

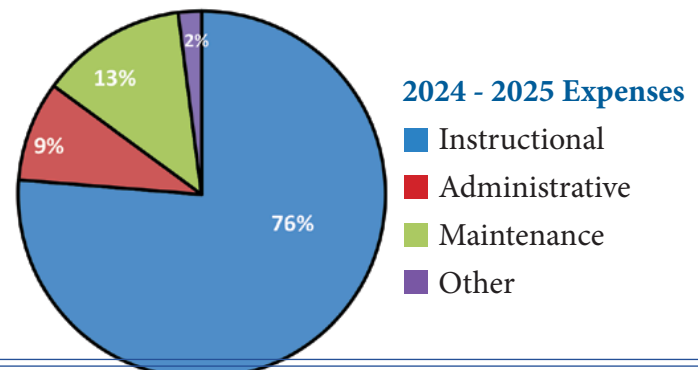
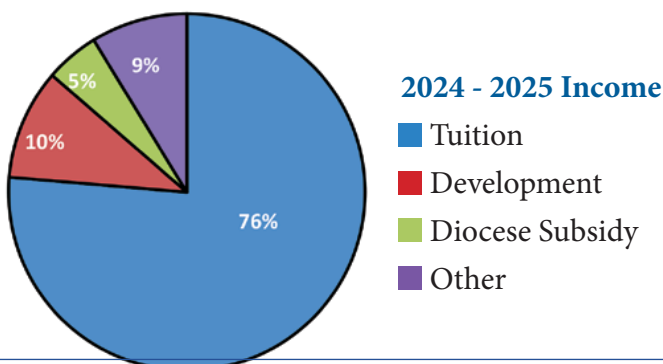
